We also run online platforms and twin with regions around the world that share this vision.

What are we looking for?

People and organisations to work with us to provide opportunities for writers to develop or showcase their work. We are looking for local, national and international channel partners.

To make a lasting change, we need help from everyone. We need connections with all parts of the writing community to ensure that our work really is Writing for All and not Writing for Some.

Partners may be writers or educators with established projects, educational charities or community groups, industry creatives, publishers, producers, agents, promoters, booksellers, industry organisations, venues or companies. Most importantly, partners share Writing for All's vision of creating an inclusive writing ecology.

What will the channel partners do?

Organisations and individuals will collaborate with us to provide a platform for writers, for example facilitating new links between existing writing projects, providing links to the publishing and touring industries, nurturing local writers, developing touring opportunities, or coproducing events.

Partnerships will take on many forms and will be tailored to each individual or organisation.
